

# Interactive boards brush

#### Survey shows tech upgrade boosts understanding and motivation

Our school has installed interactive boards in all classrooms in a strategic move to modernize education. This initiative has garnered positive feedback from students and teachers. A study conducted by *Young Breeze* reveals that 61% of surveyed students believe that they understand lesson materials better with the boards. Teachers also praised the interactive boards for their ability to simplify complex concepts and foster interactive learning through mind maps and dynamic methods.


#### Making lessons more engaging


Mr. Kevin Chow, the Vice-Principal overseeing the recent upgrade of interactive boards in all classrooms, emphasized that this strategic move aims to replace traditional projectors and screens with advanced interactive blackboards, which are designed to foster more dynamic and engaging classroom dynamics. According to Mr. Chow, "We want to provide our students with the best possible tools to succeed," highlighting that interactive boards are integral to this vision.

Mr. Chow added that the interactive boards enable teachers and students to collaborate real-time through features

like touch sensitivity, multimedia integration, and instant feedback. "This allows for lessons that cater to varied learning styles, making lessons more inclusive and participatory. Every student can actively engage in the lesson by writing, drawing, or manipulating digital elements directly on the board, which not only enhances their understanding but also enriches their overall experience," remarked Mr. Chow.

Furthermore, the school has implemented training programs for teachers to maximize the effectiveness of these tools in their teaching methodologies, ensuring that both educators and learners benefit from this significant upgrade.





#### Student participation

Ms. Leung, our Geography teacher, appreciates that she is now able to invite students to write or draw diagrams and charts on the board, which boosts students' participation and helps her break down and explain complex concepts.

Ms. Leung has designed successful activities involving students creating notes and drawing mind maps together on the board. "These have been a hit with my students," she remarked.


#### Boosting understanding and motivation

Young Breeze conducted an anonymous survey in September which collected about 80 responses from students from different forms, which revealed that 85% of students reported that their teachers use the interactive boards

every day or several times a week. Notably, 61% of students agreed that the interactive board improved their understanding of lesson materials, a testament to the boards' effectiveness in enhancing student learning.

Our survey shows that 45% of students feel more motivated and engaged in class.


The interactive boards' touch functionality and high-definition display have been particularly praised by students. A Secondary 3 student noted, "With the interactive board, the teacher no longer needs to waste time setting up the projector, making lessons more efficient." Some students noted that the improved clarity of the interactive board has even helped them to see the board better, compared to traditional projectors.



#### Better student presentations

Ms. Lam, our English teacher, was inspired by a professional development workshop and has been exploring the boards' capabilities. "The visual and interactive elements capture students' attention more effectively than traditional methods," she said.

She noticed that student' presentations have become more dynamic. "When making a presentation, students can now simply swipe on the touchscreen to change the PowerPoint slides without having to be tied to the mouse or keyboard. The presenters can engage the audience much better now," Ms. Lam said.



#### **Exciting future**

With their high-definition displays, touch functionality, and ability to facilitate collaboration and creativity, this initiative not only prepares students for a tech-driven future, but also creates a more engaging, interactive, and enjoyable learning environment. Mr. Kevin Chow said, "we are committed to exploring new ways to harness the potential of new technologies, and I am very excited about what the future has to offer."

## 象棋和話劇成就校友校董陳劍鴻

於銀行任職副總裁的校友校董陳劍鴻先生接受《融風》專訪,回溯往事。儘管2000年中七畢業的陳校董已離校多年,但仍深植陳融中學這片沃土之上。談起往昔、憶起故人,他總是眉飛色舞,純真與美好湧上心頭。

陳校董自侃幼時略胖,但自中二接觸籃球後,身型便瘦下來了。每當放學鐘聲響起,他 便如離弦之箭般衝向球場。如今想起,真是既 青春,又帶有幾分稚氣。

放學的時間屬於籃球,小息的時間則留給象棋。在機緣巧合下,他加入了象棋學會,認識了李浩芬老師。李老師常以棋局帶出人生哲理:「棋局有時處於上風,有時處於下風;好比人生順逆,最重要是遇事沉著,細心分析。遇事總能晏然自若的李老師是我的明燈、榜樣,令我在瞬息萬變的金融界從容面對。」在李老師的教導下,陳校董領悟到棋盤雖小,方寸間已是人生萬象。

世事的確如棋般變化不定,正如陳校董曾 經厭倦會計科,而今卻從事金融行業。「當 你發掘到事情的趣味和意義,自然能沉醉其 中。」他在求學時曾認為會計科沒趣,甚至缺

考一場會計考試。但經過老師的諄諄教導和自己的一番堅持,會計竟成為他日後成績最好的科目。學貴心悟,他及後悟出會計的奧妙之處:「一份財務報表好比一家公司的驗身報告,看懂這份報告就能成為『金融醫生』,看

我們問陳校董他最難忘的是陳融的哪個地方,他眼泛點點淚光,回答説:「是禮堂」。 學生時代的難忘時刻幾乎都在禮堂發生。如今 憶起往事,那些美好的瞬間仍念茲在茲:中一 時的共歡唱,當時甚至有同學唱起了民謠《鳳 陽花鼓》、交際舞活動中不小心踩到夥伴的 腳、一齣齣的福音話劇……

中二時,在班主任的推薦下,陳校董參演 了由牧師主辦的福音話劇,認識了基督。然而 剛開始,他並不相信神。「福音話劇將福音帶 進我的生命,雖然起初我並不明白信仰的真 義,但在五光十色的金融世界中,只要稍一不 慎,便會墮入誘惑的陷阱,這時我才明白到要 以自己的內心為尺,方能走上正道。」直至離校後,他才活出信仰人生。我們從陳校董口中聽到一個充滿戲劇效果的信仰故事:有些道理在年輕時未必明白,但經過時間的沉澱,在往後的人生階段中終有領悟的一天。

說到這裏,陳校董話鋒一轉,自豪地說:「當年我話 劇領銜演出,表現出色,更勇奪最佳男主角呢!」

當年的陳校董在球場上揮汗馳騁,充滿激情與活力;在棋盤上運籌帷幄,教他沉着應對;投考會計科,為他開啟金融界的大門;參演福音話劇,建立他的價值觀。當年那些看似輕描淡寫的決定,卻在他心裡埋下正直的種子。這些種子發芽需時,但它們終究會茁壯成長。正如陳校董從一顆小樹苗長成了大樹,在金融界結出纍纍碩果,使他在社會的大舞臺上綻放融兒的光彩。及後陳校董回歸母校擔任校董一職,以所學滋養這一片土壤。

多年的滄海桑田並未改變陳融的本質:一場場象棋比 賽仍在此舉行、無數的球賽及話劇仍在此火熱上演。「陳 融中學用愛的形式,去培育每一代融兒。大家也要把愛傳 出去,做一個愛神愛人的人。」這是陳校董的感悟,也是 他對同學們的寄語。


### 徐文琪 香港中文大學 金融科技
